# **Elan Celebrates National Skilled Nursing Care Week**


HONORING THE ESSENTIAL ROLE OF SKILLED NURSING CARE CENTERS

# Stronger Every Day: Elan's Path to Excellence in Dialysis Care



The unit features a comfortable common area with a kitchen, reclining chairs, and large television. This new space also increased our maximum capacity for memory care residents, allowing us to serve even more members of our community.

In October 2024, we hosted the Scranton Chamber of Commerce for an open house and ribbon cutting ceremony. Our team worked together to throw a beautiful reception for the evening. We are grateful to our board members, families, and friends in the community who came out to celebrate the completion of the unit.



We were thrilled to finally welcome our residents into their new home in March 2025. Residents are able to enjoy meals together, play games, and relax while staff are close at hand, and locked doors and elevators allow for added safety.
